The world has come to know Daniel Pearl as the *Wall Street Journal* reporter who was murdered by terrorists in Pakistan, in early 2002. Since then, he has been remembered more for his courageous work than for his senseless death. Guided by shared values and inspired by Daniel's legacy, Professors Judea Pearl and Akbar Ahmed will discuss Muslim-Jewish relations with New York City audiences for the first time. Stressing the necessity of reconciliation, Professors Pearl and Ahmed strive to shift the nature of discourse from accusation and fear to inquiry and respect.

Akbar Ahmed is the Ibn Khaldun Chair of Islamic Studies and Professor of International Relations at American University, and former Pakistani Ambassador to the United Kingdom. Judea Pearl, father of Daniel Pearl, is President of the Daniel Pearl Foundation and Professor of Computer Science at UCLA.
